1. Getting to ICC Wales

Where is ICC Wales?

ICC Wales is part of The Celtic Collection and is located within the grounds of the Celtic Manor Resort, adjacent to Junction 24 of the M4 on the outskirts of Newport, South Wales.

Where can I park?

ICC Wales offers convenient underground parking, with additional parking across the wider resort. Parking charges apply in all areas, please [view our website](#) for more information on parking.

2. Tickets & Entry

When will I receive my tickets?

All tickets are issued as e-tickets and will be emailed to you as soon as your booking is completed.

Do I need to bring my ticket with me?

Yes. Please show your e-ticket on your mobile device for scanning at The Great Skate host desk, or bring a printed copy if you prefer. We are unable to print tickets at the venue.

When should I arrive?

Please report to the host desk 15 minutes before your session start time. You are welcome to arrive earlier or stay after your session to enjoy our Christmas food, drink and stalls.

What if I can't make my session?

Tickets are non-refundable and cannot be transferred to an alternative date. This applies in all circumstances, including inclement weather that may prevent travel to the venue.

3. The Great Skate Experience

Where is the Great Skate taking place?

The Great Skate is located indoors in the Main Hall at ICC Wales. Please follow The Great Skate signage from the car park.

Is it a real ice rink?

Yes - our rink is made of real ice!

How long is a session?

Each session is 40 minutes.

4. Children, Skates & Safety

What age is The Great Skate suitable for?

The smallest skate size available is EUR 25 (UK child size 7.5). The largest skate size available is EUR 49 (UK size 15). Bob skates are available for smaller children and fit over shoes.

Do I need to skate with my children?

- Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult on the ice:
 - 4-8 years old 1 adult to 2 children
 - 8-12 years old 1 adult to 4 children
- Children over 12 must have parental supervision near the rink

Will skate aids be available?

Yes. A limited number of skate aids are available and can be booked and paid for in advance via your account, or on the day, subject to availability.

5. Comfort & Facilities

Will it be cold?

Yes, the rink area is cold. Coats and gloves are recommended.

Can I watch the skating?

Yes, there is a designated viewing area around the rink.

Where can I buy food and drinks?

You will be able to purchase food and drinks from our stands at least one hour before, until one hour after your skate session.



5. Comfort & Facilities (Continued)

Is there somewhere to store my bags?

Yes, there is space available to store a small bag along with your shoes.

Can I bring my own skates?

Yes, you are welcome to bring your own skates.

6. Accessibility

- Wheelchairs & Ice Skating

Wheelchair users are welcome on the ice, with a separate access point. If you require a wheelchair ticket, please contact the box office team on 01633 410250 or boxoffice@iccwales.com.

- Blue Badge Parking

20 designated underground Blue Badge spaces are available (parking charges apply).

- Accessible Toilets

Fully accessible toilets for men and women are available on every level.
