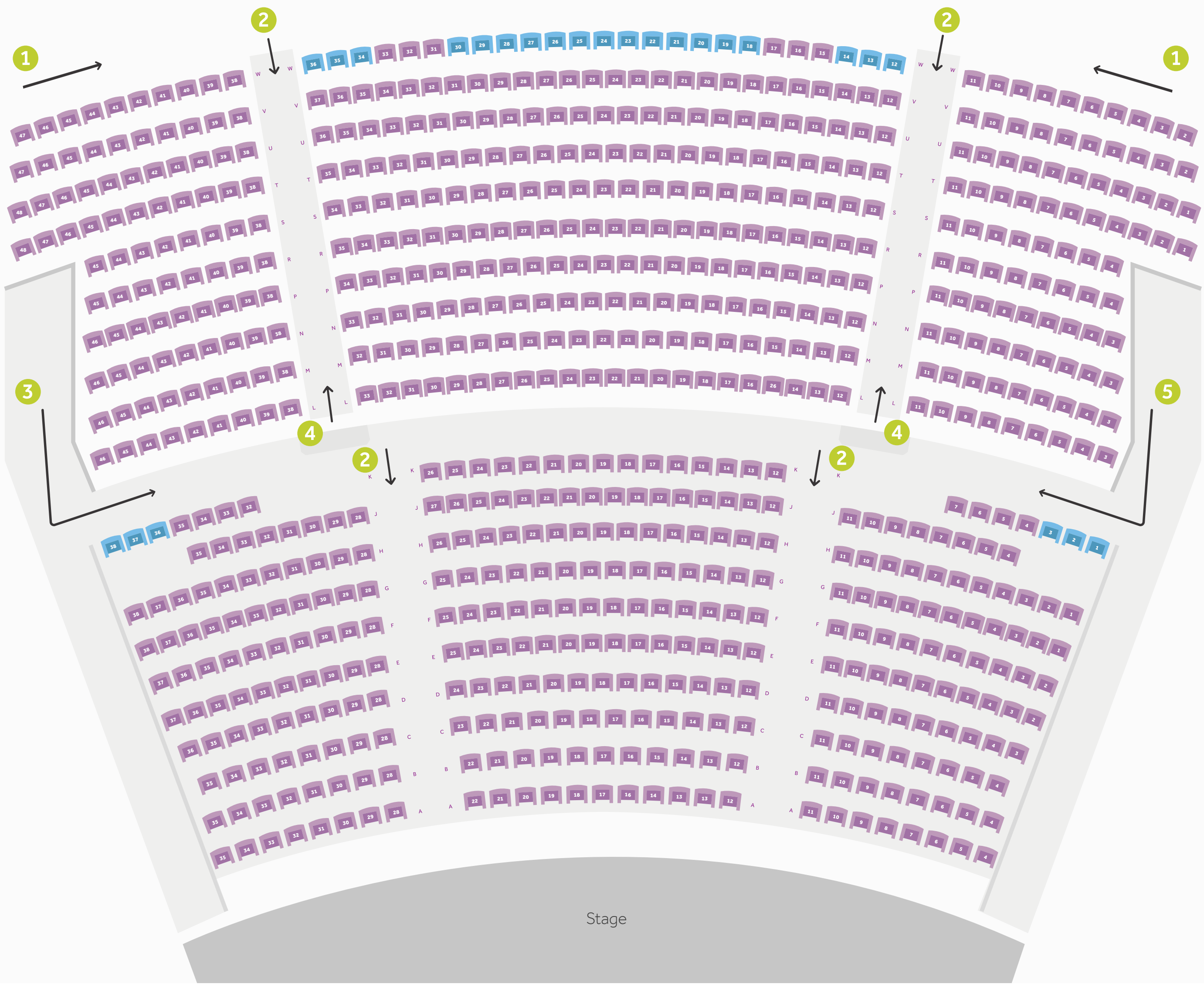


# Auditorium Seating Plan













## Lower Stalls

-  Restricted View Seating

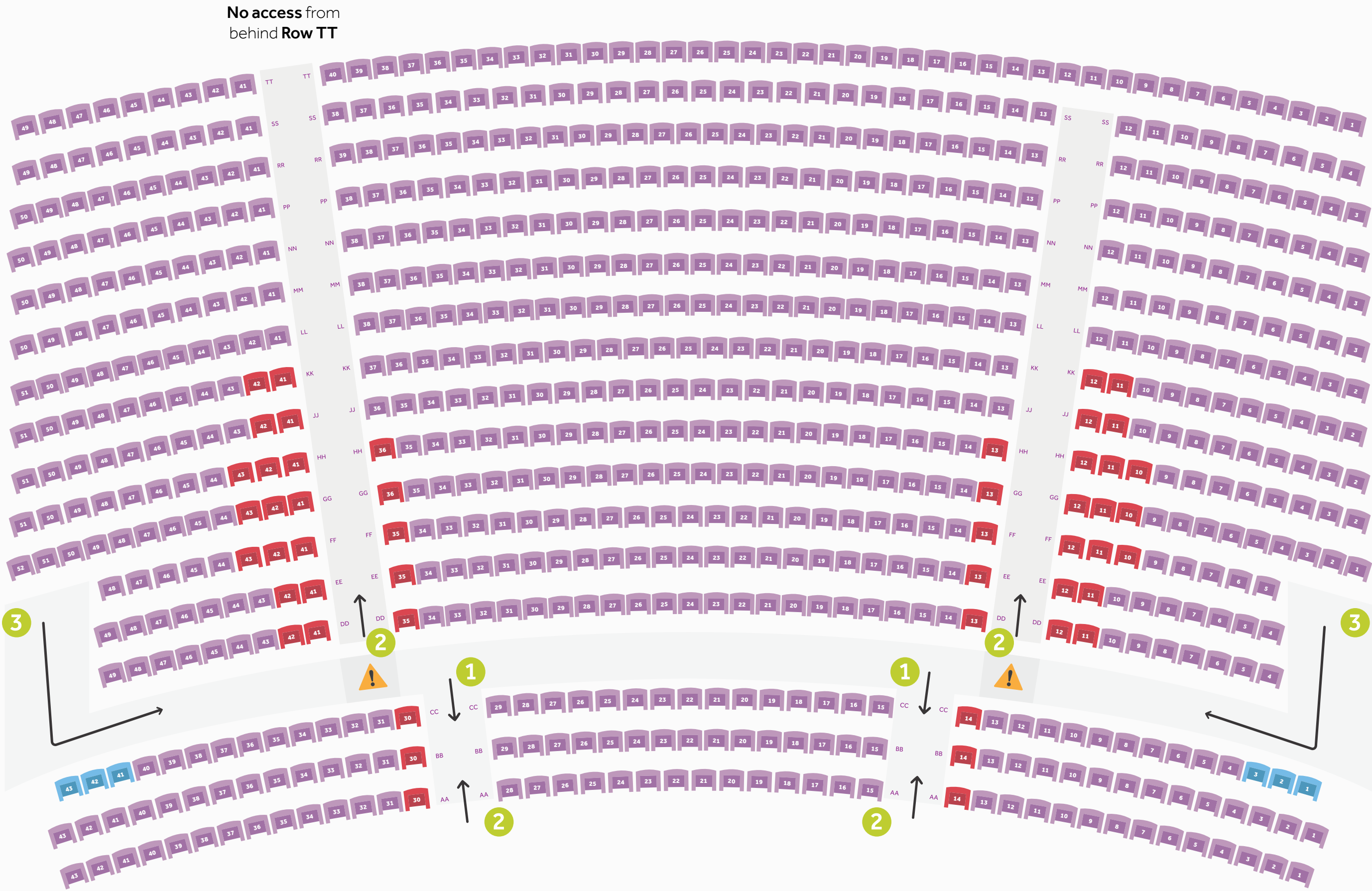
-  Flat Access From Atrium

### Accessibility Information







- Removable wheelchair positions with flat access from the atrium are:  
**W12-W14, W18-30 and W34-36**
- Removable wheelchair positions on the lower tier with access via a lift are:  
**K1-3 and K36-K38**
- Removable wheelchair positions on the upper tier with access via lift are :  
**CC1-CC3 and CC36-CC38**

Visitors with mobility issues or who find stairs difficult should choose seats in row **W** which have flat floor access from the atrium and up to 3 short stairs. Alternatively row **J** and **K** on the lower tier which can be accessed via the lift.

### Accessibility Information

Visitors with mobility issues who need easy access should choose seats in rows **AA-EE** which are accessed using a max of 5 short stairs

There is no access to rows **DD-TT** from behind row **TT** all access is up via the stairs from row DD so anyone with mobility issues should choose seats in the lowest rows and close to an aisle.

 Rows **DD-TT** have a steep rake with access from the bottom only. For easier access, guests with limited mobility are advised to select seats in rows **AA-EE** and near the aisles where possible.
